T Lift is a door-to-door, shared ride paratransit service provided by the City of Lawrence. T Lift service is available for transit riders who, because of a disability, are unable to use the fixed routes.

Night Line is the after-hours shared ride bus service for those who don't work on a traditional schedule.

SafeRide is a demand-response service giving students a ride home from anywhere within the city limits.
