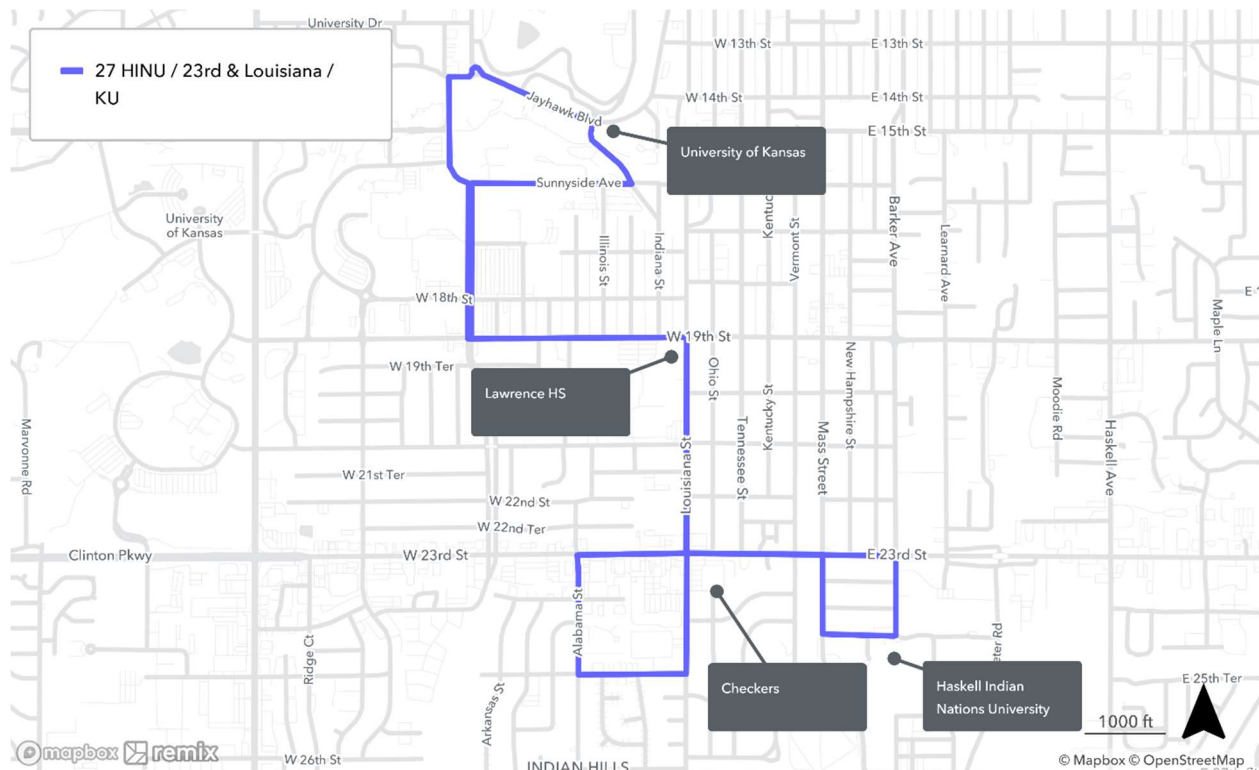
What are the proposed changes?

A brief overview of Route 27 proposed scenarios

Current Route 27

Route 27 currently travels between Haskell Indian Nations University and the University of Kansas and passes by Checkers and Lawrence High School. A map of the current route is shown below.

Route 27– Scenario 1

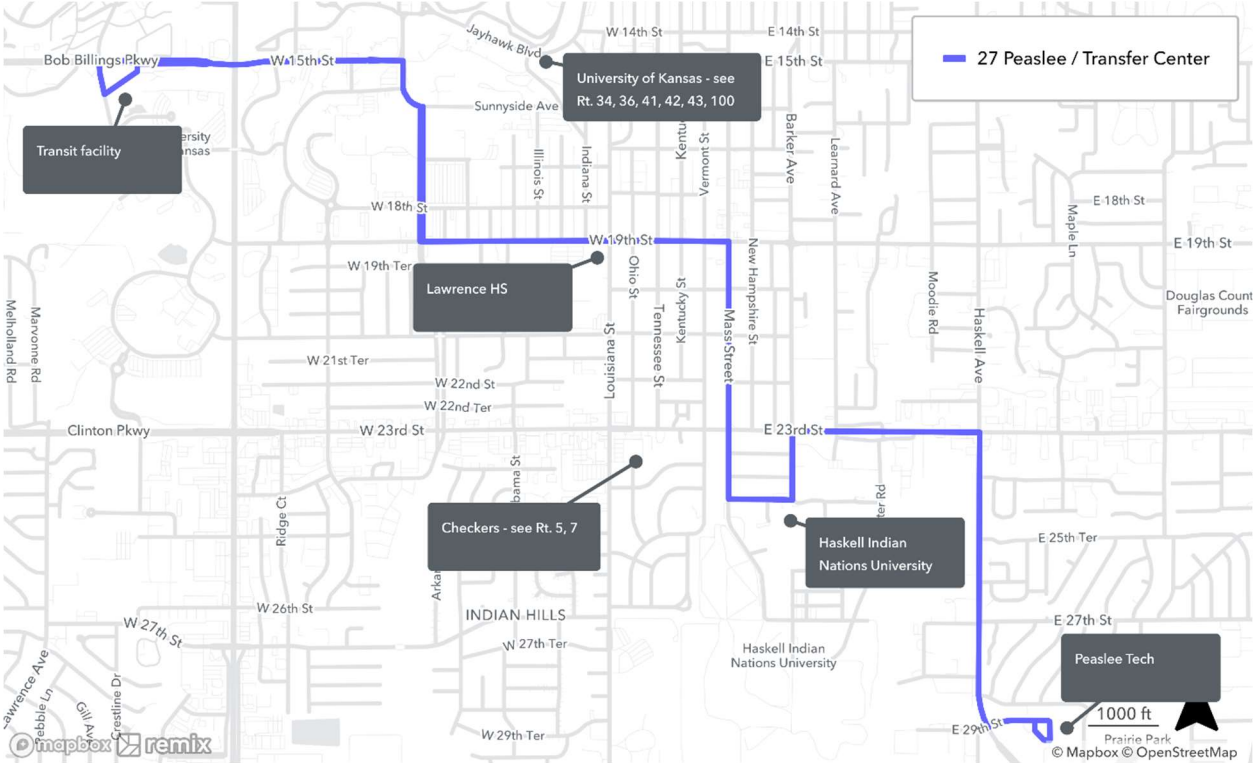
The idea for Route 27 in Scenario 1 is to connect the transfer facility at Bob Billings & Crestline to several educational institutions. The route would travel between Peaslee Tech and the transfer facility and pass by Haskell, Lawrence High School, and the University of Kansas.

Checkers would be served by Routes 5 and 7, and Jayhawk Blvd would be served by Routes 34, 36, 41, 42, 43, and 100. East of Tennessee St. and south of 23rd St. would be served by microtransit.

WHAT IS MICROTRANSIT?

Microtransit functions like ride-sharing services Uber and Lyft, but it uses transit vehicles and offers affordable and predictable fares.

The idea for Route 27 in Scenario 2 is to connect the transfer facility at Bob Billings & Crestline to several educational institutions in the same way as Scenario 1. The route would travel between Peaslee Tech and the transfer facility and pass by Haskell, Lawrence High School, and the University of Kansas.

Checkers would be served by Routes 5 and 7, and Jayhawk Blvd would be served by Routes 34, 36, 41, 42, 43, and 100.
