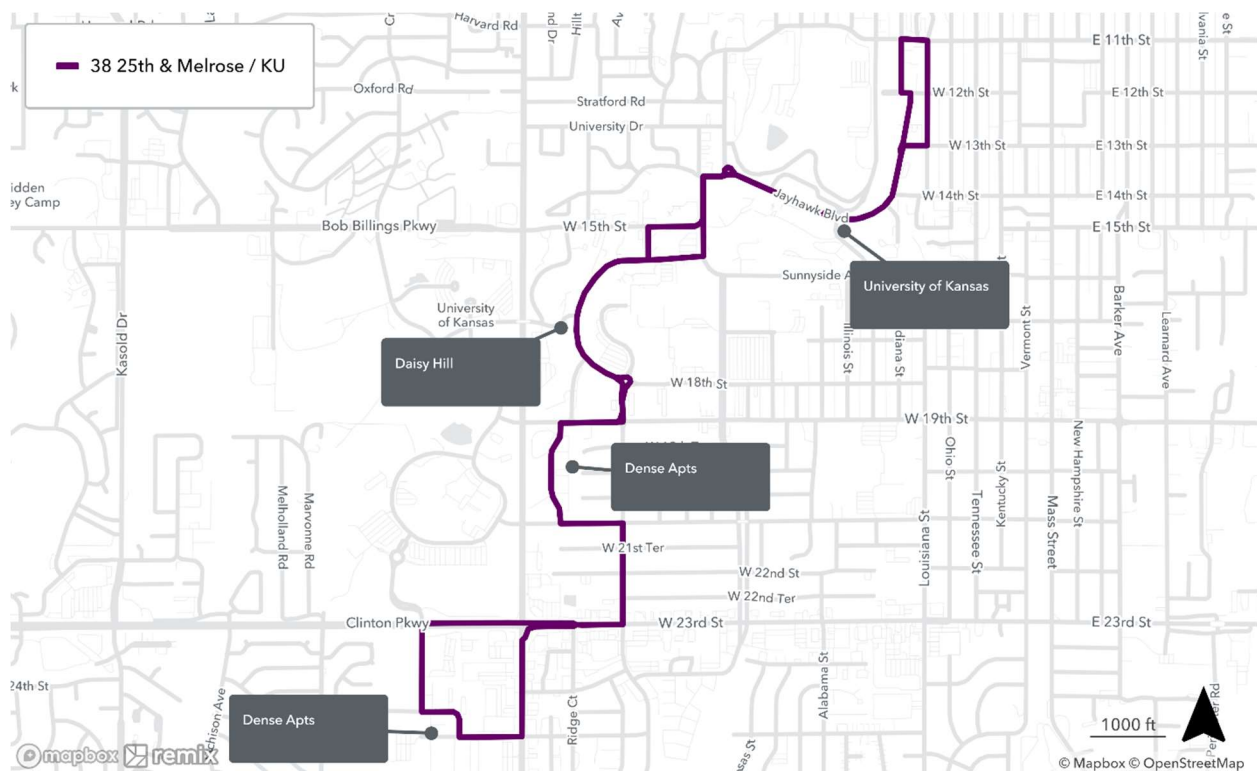
What are the proposed changes?

A brief overview of Route 38 proposed scenarios

Current Route 38

Route 38 currently travels between KU and dense apartments at W. 25th & Melrose and passes by Daisy Hill and additional apartments on Stewart Avenue. A map of the current route is shown below.

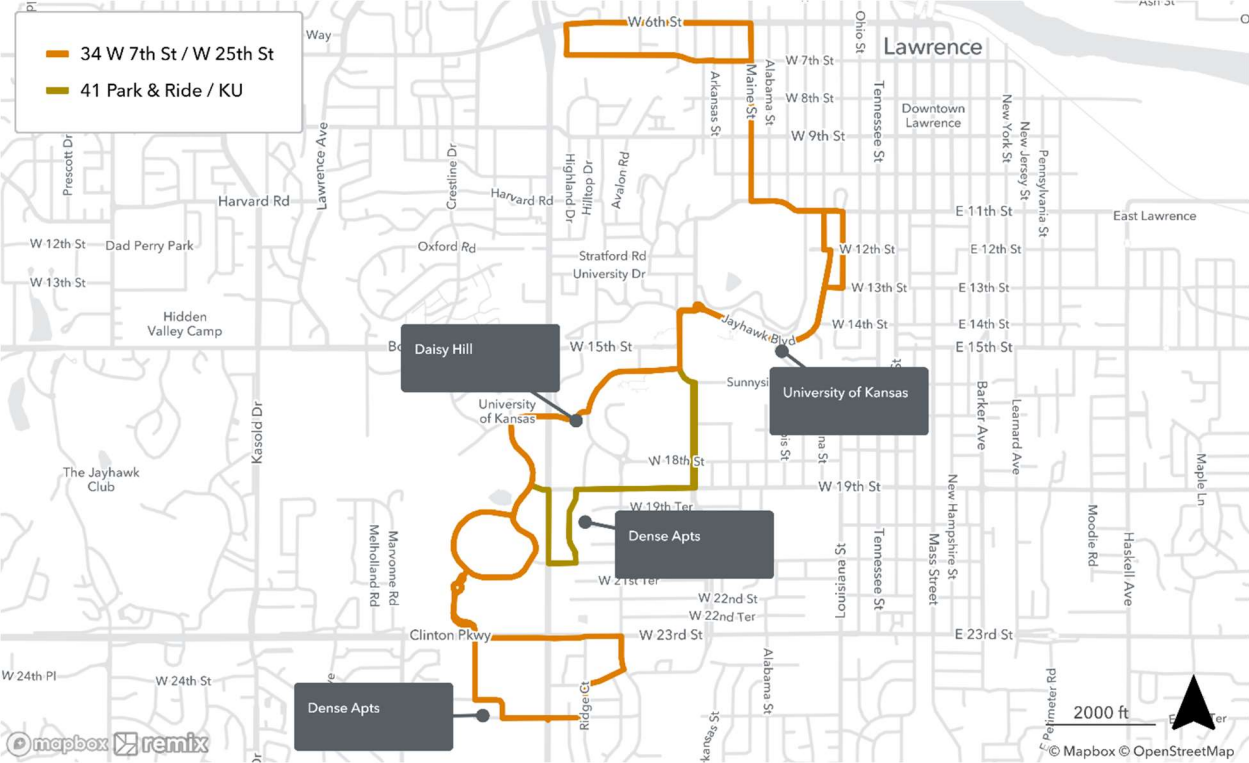
Route 38 – Current



Route 38– Scenario 1

Scenario 1 does not include a proposed Route 38. Instead, portions of existing Route 38 are incorporated into Routes 34 and 41 in Scenario 1. A map of Routes 34 and 41 from Scenario 1 is shown below.

Route 38– Scenario 2

In Scenario 2, Route 38 would end at the transfer facility at Bob Billings & Crestline instead of the Kansas Union and extend south to South Iowa St. passing by dense apartments along the way, the post office, Wal-Mart, Target, and Aldi's.

Route 38 would interline with Route 11, which means that someone connecting to Route 11 from Route 38 at The Reserve would not need to change buses. Southbound Route 38 buses become northbound Route 11 buses by changing their headsign at The Reserve, and vice versa. Interlining helps passengers make their connection between the two routes because they don't have to get off the bus.

Jayhawk Blvd, which would no longer be served directly by Route 38, is proposed to be served by other fixed routes, including fast and frequent connections from the transfer facility to campus and downtown via Route 100.
