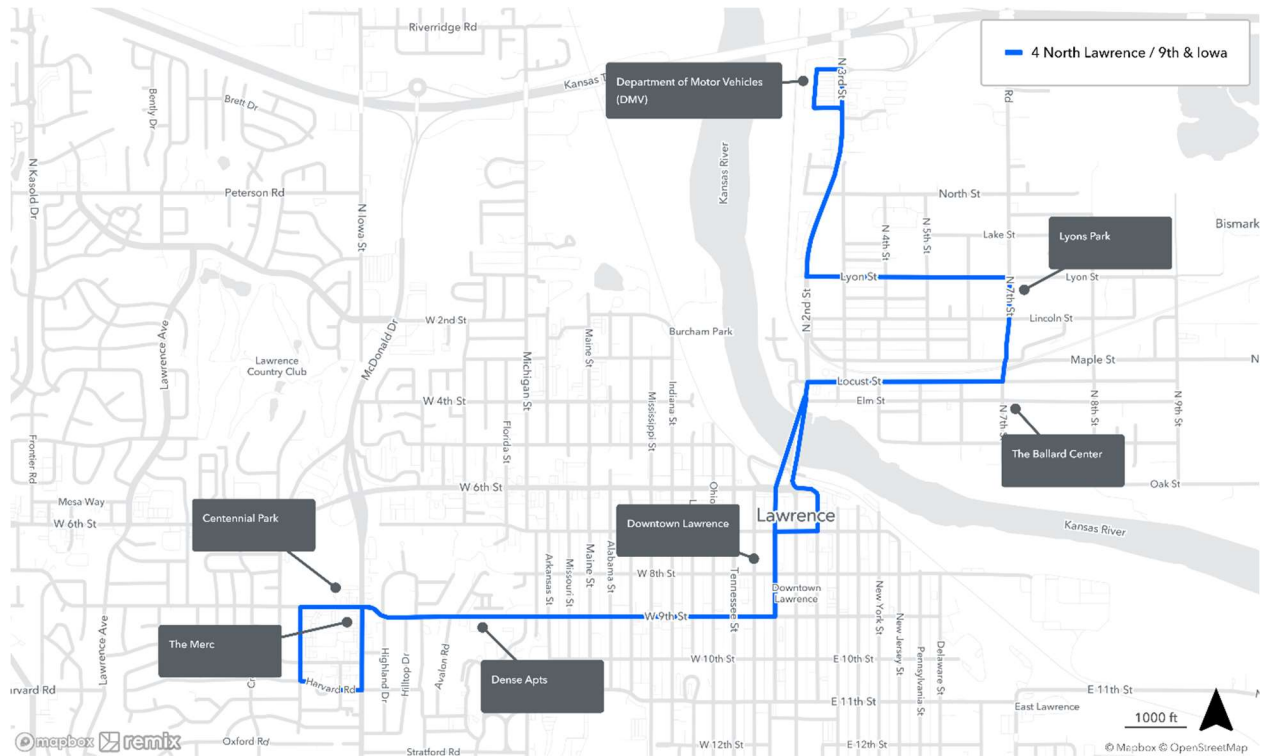
What are the proposed changes?

A brief overview of Route 4 proposed scenarios

Current Route 4

Route 4 currently travels between North Lawrence, Downtown, and 9th & Iowa, passing by the DMV, Lyons Park, The Ballard Center, The Merc, and Centennial Park. A map of the current route is shown below.

Route 4 – Scenario 1

The idea for Route 4 in Scenario 1 is replace service along 9th St. with service on the 6th St. corridor. The new Route 4 would connect North Lawrence to multiple grocery stores, Free State High School, Rock Chalk Park, and LMH Health West. It also shifts service to North St. in North Lawrence to directly serve Riverside Homes.

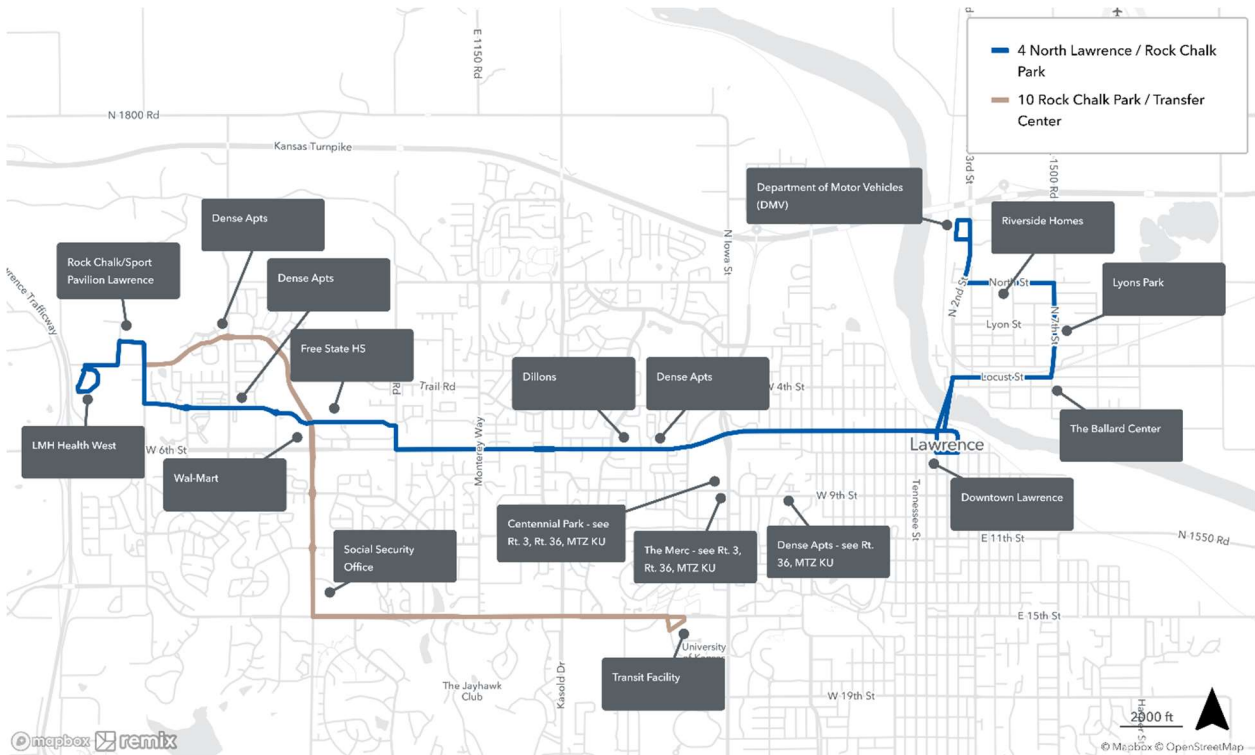
Additionally, Route 4 would interline with Route 10, which means that someone connecting to Route 10 from Route 4 at Rock Chalk Park would not need to change buses. Westbound Route 4 buses become eastbound Route 10 buses by changing their headsign at Rock Chalk Park, and vice versa. Interlining helps passengers make their connection between the two routes because they don't have to get off the bus.

Destinations along the 9th St. corridor that would no longer be served by Route 4 are proposed to be served by Route 3, Route 36, and microtransit.

WHAT IS MICROTRANSIT?

Microtransit functions like ride-sharing services Uber and Lyft, but it uses transit vehicles and offers affordable and predictable fares.

Route 4 – Scenario 2

The idea for Route 4 in Scenario 2 is to extend service from The Merc to the new transfer facility on Bob Billings. It also shifts service to North St. in North Lawrence to directly serve Riverside Homes.

This Route 4 option would connect with several routes at the new transfer facility and create a connection from the new facility to Downtown that bypasses KU.
