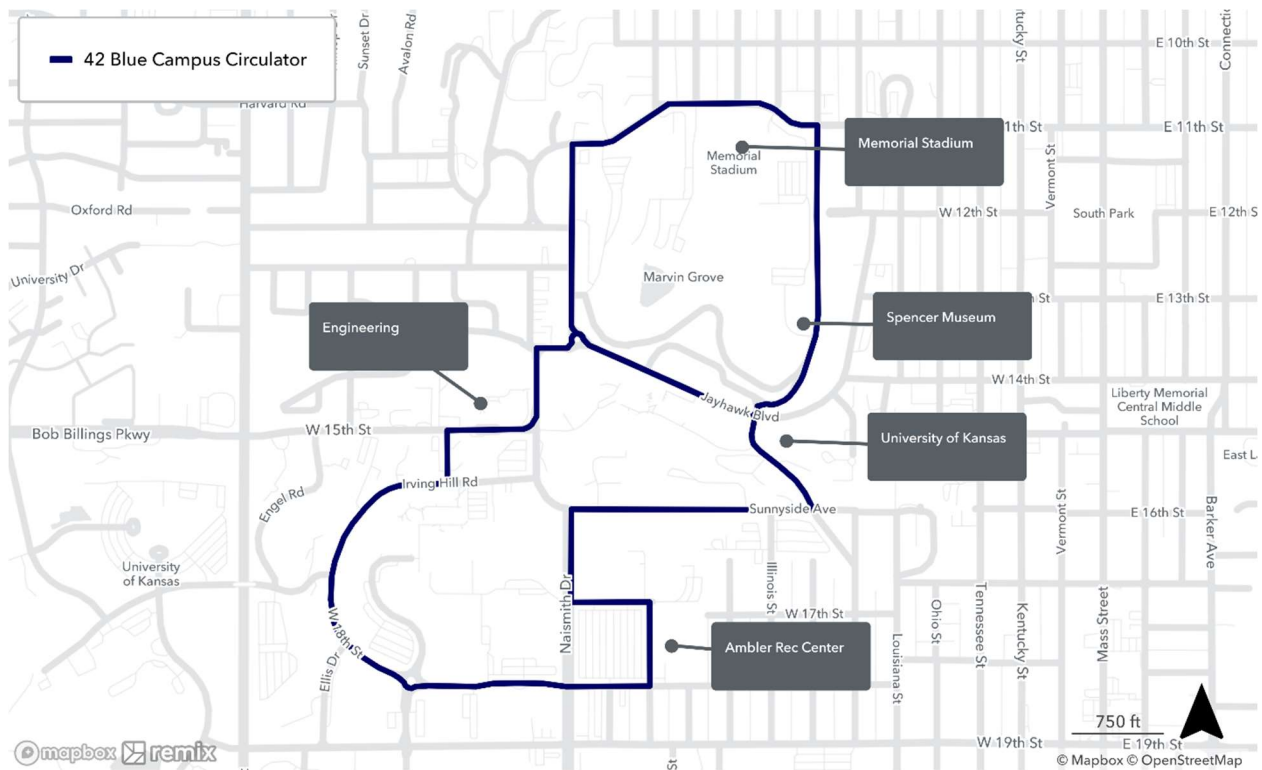
What are the proposed changes?

A brief overview of Route 42 proposed scenarios

Current Route 42

Route 42 currently travels between the Ambler Rec Center and Kansas Union and passes by the Spencer Museum of Art, Engineering, and Memorial Stadium. A map of the current route is shown below.

Route 42– Scenario 1

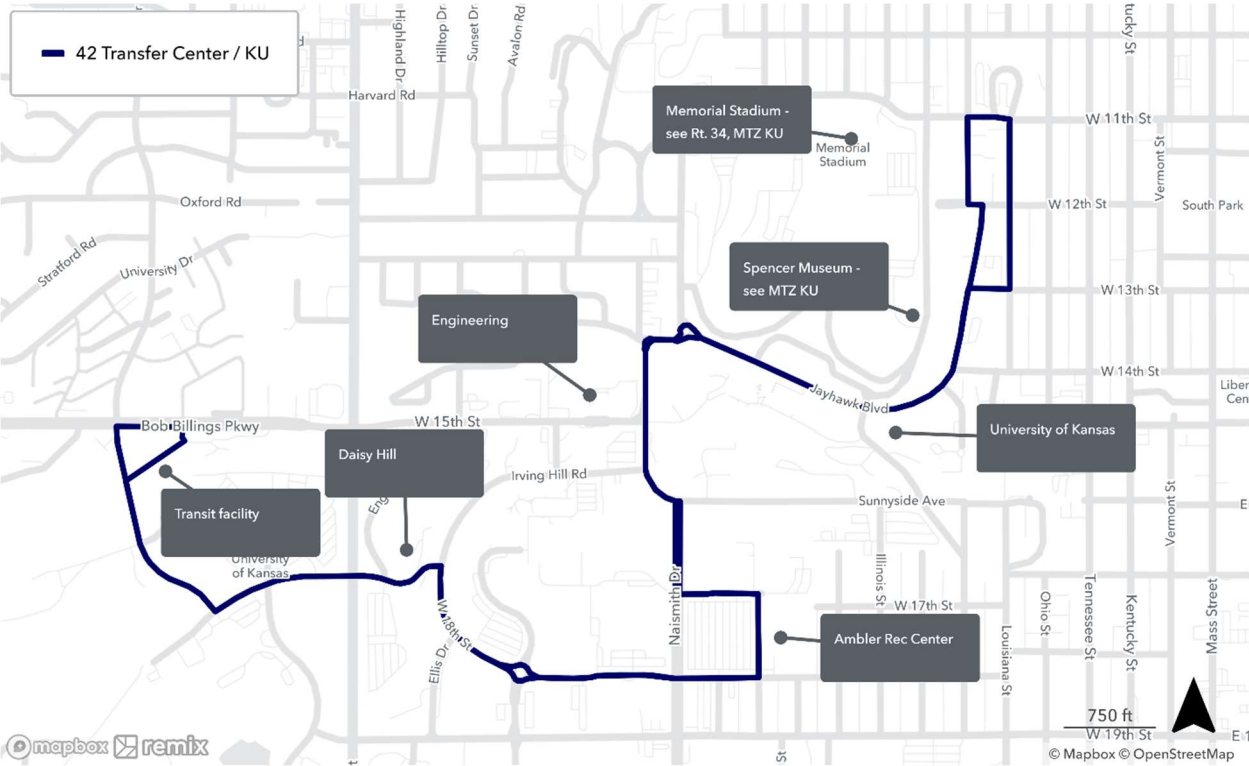
The idea for Route 42 in Scenario 1 is to connect the transit facility at Bob Billings & Crestline to KU and pass by Daisy Hill and the Ambler Rec Center.

Memorial Stadium and the Spencer Art Museum would no longer be served by Route 42 and would instead be served by Route 34 and microtransit.

WHAT IS MICROTRANSIT?

Microtransit functions like ride-sharing services Uber and Lyft, but it uses transit vehicles and offers affordable and predictable fares.

Route 42– Scenario 2

The idea for Route 42 in Scenario 2 is to connect the transit facility at Bob Billings & Crestline to KU and pass by Daisy Hill and the Ambler Rec Center. What differentiates this version of Route 42 from Scenario 1 is that it serves Jayhawk Blvd and Sunnyside Ave with a one-direction loop and does not serve the Kansas Union.

Memorial Stadium and the Spencer Art Museum would no longer be served by Route 42 and would instead be served by Route 34 and microtransit.
